

## 3 Day Company Security Officer Training Course (NZ)

ISPS Code & NZ Maritime Security Act & Regulations 2004. To the requirements of IMO Model Course 3.20 (2012).

This intensive and interactive course is delivered by Scott McEwan AFNI, an Australian former shipping industry executive and today, one of Oceania's recognised authorities on the ISPS Code and ship / port facility security management systems implementation.

### Aims

To provide essential knowledge to those who may be designated by the operator of a ship, MODU or self-propelled FPSO/FSU, to perform the duties of a Company Security Officer with responsibility for preparing ship security assessments, development and implementation of the company's ship security policy and assisting the company's Ship Security Officers to properly implement and maintain their security plan.

Topics covered include:

- Practical understanding of the ISPS Code & the NZ Maritime Security Act & Regulations 2004
- Roles & responsibilities of government authorities and the shipping & offshore industries
- Maritime & offshore security threats and vulnerabilities
- Access control for ships, ports, port and offshore facilities, security zones, identification systems
- General risk assessment principles – risk, threat and vulnerability – ISO 31000:2018
- Ship security assessments – development and reviews
- Ship security plans – development, maintenance, equipment, training, drills, exercises, audits and record-keeping requirements
- Maritime security levels, security threats and hardening on-board defences – BMP5
- Correct usage of the Declaration of Security
- Weapons and improvised explosive devices – methods of concealment and locations
- Encouraging a security awareness and vigilance culture – incident & event reporting
- The meaning in practical terms of providing support to Masters and SSOs
- Effective liaison with port facility security officers – maintaining critical communications

### Who should attend

This course is for persons who will be required to perform the duties of a security officer as defined in the ISPS Code (Part A/11.2) and the NZ Maritime Security Regulations 2004 (Part 2). The course is also suitable for offshore facility operators and law enforcement officers.

### Entry standards

A basic understanding of the ISPS Code, maritime transport and/or offshore facility security arrangements would be helpful. However, there are no specific entry requirements.

### Locations & size

The course is delivered in main cities and at regional ports. The minimum per course is 4 and for maximum interactivity, the maximum is normally limited to 8.
