

3 Day Company Security Officer Training Course (PNG)

ISPS Code & PNG MS (Maritime Security) Regulation 2013. To the requirements of IMO Model Course 3.20 (2012).

This intensive and interactive course is delivered by Scott McEwan AFNI, an Australian former shipping industry executive and today, one of Oceania's recognised authorities on the ISPS Code and ship & port facility security management systems implementation.

Aims

To provide essential knowledge to those who may be designated by the operator of a ship, MODU or self-propelled FPSO/FSU, to perform the duties of a Company Security Officer with responsibility for preparing ship security assessments and the development and implementation of the company's ship security policy and assisting the company's Ship Security Officers to properly implement and maintain their security plan.

Topics covered include:

- Practical understanding of the SOLAS Convention's Chapter XI-2, the ISPS Code & the PNG Merchant Shipping (Maritime Security) Regulation 2013.
- Roles & responsibilities of government authorities and the shipping & offshore industries
- Maritime & offshore security threats and vulnerabilities
- Access control for ships, ports, port and offshore facilities, security zones, identification systems
- General risk assessment principles – risk, threat and vulnerability – ISO 31000:2009
- Ship security assessments – development and reviews
- Ship security plans – development, maintenance, equipment, training, drills, exercises, audits and record-keeping requirements
- Maritime security levels, recognition and responses to security threats – BMP4
- Correct usage of the Declaration of Security
- Weapons and improvised explosive devices – methods of concealment
- Bomb searches and on-board security considerations
- Encouraging a security awareness and vigilance culture – incident & event reporting
- Providing support to Masters and SSOs – like a DPA does, under the ISM Code
- Effective liaison with port and port facility operators

Who should attend

This course is for persons who will be required to perform the duties of a security officer as defined in the ISPS Code (Part A/11.2) and the PNG Merchant Shipping (Maritime Security) Regulations 2013.

The course is also suitable for offshore facility operators and law enforcement officers.

Entry standards

Knowledge of ship operations, maritime transport and/or offshore facility safety and security arrangements would be helpful. Seagoing experience at a senior officer level is desirable but not essential.

Locations & size

The course is delivered in main cities and at regional ports. The minimum per course is 4 and for maximum interactivity, the maximum is normally limited to 8.
