

1 Day ISPS Code & Merchant Shipping (Security Regulations) Awareness Training Course for PNG Maritime Security Guards

ISPS Code & PNG MS (Maritime Security) Regulations 2013. Syllabus based on the IMO Model Course 3.25 (2011).

This short and interactive course is delivered by Scott McEwan AFNI, a former shipping industry executive and one of Australia's recognised authorities on the ISPS Code and maritime security management systems implementation.

Aims

To provide essential maritime security awareness knowledge to those who may be designated to perform the duties of a Maritime Security Guard with responsibility for maintaining the integrity of a port security restricted area.

Topics covered include:

- Relevant sections of the ISPS Code & of the PNG Merchant Shipping (Maritime Security) Regulations (2013)
- Responsibilities of governments, ships, ports, facilities – including employees & contractors
- Key roles:
 - Government and its designated authority
 - Ships – Company Security Officer, Ship Master, Ship Security Officer & other seafarers
 - Ports – Port Facility Security Officers
 - Officials & law enforcement officers
 - MS Guards' powers & responsibilities
- Current maritime security threats and vulnerabilities
- Recognition on a non-discriminatory basis of persons potentially posing potential security risks
- Recognition and detection of weapons, prohibited items, dangerous substances and devices
- Maritime security levels 1, 2 & 3 and security measures actions typically applied at different levels
- Maintaining a cooperative relationship with a Ship Security Officer
- Maintaining the integrity of a port security restricted areas
- Security evacuation considerations
- Maintaining awareness and vigilance – “walking the talk” at the ship / port interface
- Major incident and minor event reporting and record keeping

Who should attend

This awareness course is for persons who will be required to perform the duties of a Maritime Security Guard under the Merchant Shipping (Maritime Security) Regulations 2013.

Entry standards

A certificate or qualification and a current licence to work as a security guard.

Locations & size

Courses are delivered at Pelagus' venues or in-house with a minimum of 6 participants. For maximum learning and interactivity, class size is normally limited to 12. 1 or 2 classes per day.
