

## 2 Day Port Facility Security Officer Refresher Training (PNG)

ISPS Code & PNG MS (Maritime Security) Regulation 2013. Based on IMO Model Course 3.21 (2015)

This intensive and interactive course is delivered by Scott McEwan AFNI, a former shipping industry executive and one of Australasia's recognised authorities on the ISPS Code and maritime security management systems implementation.

### Aims

To update the essential knowledge of Port Facility Security Officers in PNG, considering global experience to date.

Topics covered include:

- Practical understanding of the SOLAS Convention's Chapter XI-2, the ISPS Code & the PNG Merchant Shipping (Maritime Security) Regulation 2013
- Roles & responsibilities of government designated authorities and industry
- Changes in the maritime security risk context – current security threats – national / regional
- Techniques used to circumvent security measures
- Recognition, on a non-discriminatory basis, of persons posing potential security risks – including trusted insiders – handling sensitive communications
- Recognition and detection of weapons, substances and devices
- Access control for ships, ports, port and offshore facilities, security zones, identification systems
- Maritime security assessment review – applying ISO 20858:2007 and ISO 31000:2009
- Maritime security plans – modifying the plan to correct deficiencies and considering changes in operating conditions
- Maritime security levels, recognition and responses to security threats and directions
- Correct usage of the Declaration of Security
- Emergency preparedness – communications, evacuations, police response
- Assigning security duties to designated facility personnel – contractor review
- Incident & event reporting – obligations and duties
- Maintaining a security awareness and vigilance culture
- Training for personnel with designated security duties and all other facility personnel
- Maintaining records

### Who should attend

This course is for persons who will be required to perform the duties of a security officer as defined in the ISPS Code (Part A/17.2) and the PNG Merchant Shipping (Maritime Security) Regulations 2013. The course is also suitable for offshore facility operators and law enforcement officers.

### Entry standards

A PFSO qualification. A copy of the original PFSO training certificate must accompany a registration.

### Locations & size

The course is delivered in main and regional ports. The minimum per course is 4 and for maximum interactivity, the maximum is normally limited to 8.

### Price per person

\$A 1,970 / PNGK 4,570 per person. Min 4 persons. This includes all course material, lunches and refreshments. Travelling expenses to regional ports may be charged. In-house discount.

### Course duration
