

3 Day Port Facility Security Officer Training Course (PNG)

ISPS Code & PNG MS (Maritime Security) Regulation 2013. To the requirements of the IMO Model Course 3.21.

This intensive and interactive course, which is recognised by the Papua New Guinea DoT, is delivered by Scott McEwan AFNI, an Australian former shipping industry executive and one of Oceania's recognised authorities on the ISPS Code and maritime security management systems implementation.

Aims

To provide essential knowledge to those who may be designated to perform the duties of a Port Facility Security Officer in PNG with responsibility for preparing port facility security assessments and developing, maintaining and supervising the implementation of an approved port facility security plan.

Topics covered include:

- Practical understanding of the SOLAS Convention's Chapter XI-2, the ISPS Code & the PNG Merchant Shipping (Maritime Security) Regulation 2013
- Roles & responsibilities of government authorities and the maritime & offshore industries
- Maritime & offshore security threats and vulnerabilities
- Access control for ships, ports, port and offshore facilities, security zones, identification systems
- General risk assessment principles – ISO 31000:2009
- Port facility Security Assessments – development and reviews – ISO 20858:2007
- Port facility Security Plans – development, maintenance, equipment, training, drills, exercises, internal and external audits and record-keeping requirements
- Maritime security levels, responding to security threats and directions
- Correct usage of the Declaration of Security
- Weapons and improvised explosive devices – methods of concealment
- Bomb searches and security evacuation considerations
- Encouraging a security awareness and vigilance culture – incident & event reporting
- Effective liaison with Ship Security Officers & Company Security Officers

Who should attend

This course is for persons who will be required to perform the duties of a security officer as defined in the ISPS Code (Part A/17.2) and the PNG Merchant Shipping (Maritime Security) Regulation 2013. The course is also suitable for offshore facility operators and law enforcement officers.

Entry standards

A basic understanding of the ISPS Code, maritime transport and/or offshore facility security arrangements would be helpful. However, there are no specific entry requirements.

Locations & size

The course is delivered in Port Moresby and at regional ports. The minimum per course is 4 and for maximum interactivity, the maximum is normally limited to 8.

Price
